

## SRIA online commenting procedure

Dear EUFORE stakeholder,

thank you very much for participating in the SRIA online commenting procedure and for your contribution in order to further elaborate the SRIA.

We have set up a Miro board for each of the four SRIA chapters. Please find the links to the board attached below.

Before starting to comment, please read the following instructions carefully in order to ensure a smooth and orderly commenting process.

1. We have set up some instructions how to use Miro boards and the sticky notes (post-it) approach. You will find it directly in the board when opening it.
2. There are columns in each board for each of the sub-chapters of a SRIA chapter. Please put your comments on the sticky notes under each of the respective sub-chapter.
3. There are differently coloured sticky notes in each board. Each colour represents a particular stakeholder branch. Please use the coloured sticky notes according to the stakeholder branch you are assigning yourself.
4. Before starting to comment, please make sure you have read the SRIA carefully and are aware of the purpose of the SRIA development process. Some short introduction can be found [here](#).
5. Before writing a sticky note, please check whether similar comments have already been made by other participants. If you feel that your comment is already on a post-it, please use the right-click "add comment" function to show your support for this post-it.
6. Please try to group comments. If you see that your comments adds or relates to comments that have already been made, group your comment around those similar ones.
7. Please do not change the initial order of the chapters. We will check from time to time and structure a bit.

You don't need to save your work when leaving Miro boards. Changes are saved automatically when closing a board.
